



<b>State legislators</b>	
<b>Salary</b>	<b>Per diem</b>
\$17,358/year	\$129/day for members establishing a second residence in Boise; \$49/day if no second residence is established and up to \$25/day travel. Set by the compensation commission.

Some legislators increase their pension payments by taking administrative positions after they serve, which converts their pension payments from the legislator payout to a full-time employee's payout.<sup>[1]</sup>

As of 2008, the salary of Idaho's governor ranked 39th among U.S. governors' salaries. The average salary earned by U.S. governors was \$128,735. The median salary earned by U.S. governors was \$129,962.<sup>[2]</sup>
